

YARD WASTE AND ELECTRONICS RECYCLING CENTER

MODIFIED WINTER HOURS

Beginning Monday, October 28th, the recycling center, located at 55 Fairview Road, New Cumberland, will observe winter hours as follows:

Monday through Friday – 9:00 a.m. to noon

Every Saturday – 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Please note, however, that the center will be closed on the following holiday dates:

Tuesday, November 5 – Election Day

Monday, November 11 – Veterans Day

Thurs/Friday, November 28/29 – Thanksgiving

Wednesday, January 1 – New Year's Day

Monday, February 17 – Presidents Day

This schedule may be adjusted again in the Spring. Check your April newsletter for any changes to the hours of operation.

You are reminded that by state law, electronic devices can no longer be disposed of with your regular trash. With Christmas coming, many of you will be getting new TVs, computers, cell phones and other electronics. All your old devices can be brought to the center to be recycled, as well as your Christmas tree to be shredded for mulch.

2013 Leaf Collection

Leaf collection will begin the week of October 28th. The last collection day will be Friday, December 6th.

► Leaves will be collected the day after your trash collection day, beginning as early as 6:00 a.m. If your trash day is Friday, leaves will be collected Monday.

► Our goal is to collect leaves once a week in your neighborhood, however weather, holidays and volume may affect this schedule

► Rake leaves close to the curb or edge of the road without blocking the roadway

► Do not place leaves on storm drains

► Do not mix grass or brush with leaves

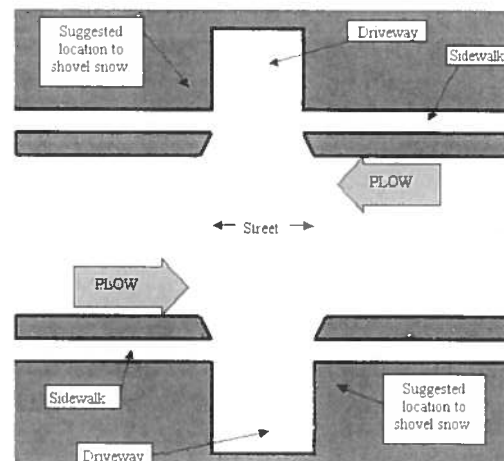
► Leaves in bags or trash cans will not be collected

Plows & Driveways

Plows travel down the right side of the roadway, in the same direction as normal traffic flow. There is no way to avoid plows putting snow at the end of driveways. To minimize the amount of snow placed by a plow, put shoveled snow on the right side of the driveway as you look from your driveway into the street.

Reminder: PennDOT provides snow removal and winter maintenance on all state roads in our Township. Call York County PennDOT at 717-848-6230 with any complaints about snow removal or ice control on these roads.

EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

The Board of Supervisors has received numerous complaints about feral cats running at large in the Township. The Board has instructed the Township staff to work with various groups in the area in an attempt to establish some type of protocol to address this issue.

More than one group has approached the Township offering suggestions on how to best address this matter. Trap-Neuter-Return has been suggested and this would coincide with a feeding program administered by these various organizations.

You must follow the preparation guidelines listed on our website to ensure collection.

ELECTRONICS

DEP- Act 108 - Effective January 2013, electronics will not be collected curbside.

The electronic recycling drop-off site is located at 55 Fairview Road, New Cumberland, PA 17070.

***Acceptable electronics are:* desktop/laptop computers, computer monitors, keyboards, computer mouse, modems, electric typewriters, televisions, cell phones, pagers, telephones, VCR's, DVD players, CD players, remote controls, radios, stereos, printers, fax machines, microwave ovens, hard drives. Residents are responsible for removal of any personal data contained on electronic devices and computer hard drives.**
