WHAT NOT TO PUT DOWN THE DRAIN

Everyday in household kitchens, large amounts of fats, oils and grease are produced which are not good for the sanitary sewer. When oil or grease is discharged into a sewer system, it will solidify and in time can build up and plug drain lines and pump stations. It will also adhere to the sides of sewer lines and begin to build up, eventually causing a backup, and severely impacting maintenance and operation costs at the sewer plants.

As ratepayers we all pay for this maintenance cost. You can help by following a few simple rules.

- **NEVER** pour grease, fat or oil from cooking down the sink drain.
- Use a paper towel to clean up the excess grease or pour grease in a container and put it in your trashcan.

In addition to grease and oil, the following items should be put in your trash can and never flushed into the sanitary sewer:

- Disposable Diapers
- Baby Wipes
- Personal Hygiene Products
- Pharmaceutical Products, Needles/Syringes

YARD WASTE & ELECTRONICS RECYCLING CENTER

The yard waste and electronics recycling center, located at 55 Fairview Road, New Cumberland, is open Monday – Saturday from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm., except holidays.

Township staff anticipates shredding the next batch of brush and tree trimmings the week of July 7th. Double-shredded mulch should be available for pick-up beginning Monday, July 21st.

YARD WASTE CONTAINERS ARE TO BE USED FOR YARD WASTE COLLECTION ONLY.

The waste hauler **WILL NOT** collect your trash or recyclables in them. Please do not dispose of yard waste in bags, boxes, etc. You must follow the preparation guidelines listed on our website to ensure collection.

Paint Disposal: Latex and oil-based paint can be disposed of in your regular household trash. Simply add shredded paper, sand or kitty litter in the can to absorb any liquid. Put lid back on can and place paint can into your household trash bag.

Hazardous Waste Disposal: Contact the York County Solid Waste Authority at 717.845.1066 (ie: paint thinners, drain cleaners, bleach, flammables (gasoline), reactive (chemistry kits) or toxic (pesticides), etc).

Disposal of FLOURESCENT LAMPS, BALLASTS & CFL'S: The Township receives several calls regarding how to recycle your fluorescent lamps, ballasts and CFL's (compact fluorescent light bulbs). Below are locations to recycle these items.
