

## MS-4 – Stormwater Management

Fairview Township has been designated as an MS-4 Community. (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System) The PA Dept of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) are requiring Fairview Township to monitor and assure that any and all water is managed properly for volume and cleanliness before it is transported out of the township. To do so, Fairview Township must enact and enforce ordinances dealing with stormwater discharges, sanitary sewers and flood plains along creeks and streams. Fairview Township has joined with other local municipalities to limit the amount of pollution in the water leaving the township that ultimately is discharged into the Chesapeake Bay. In addition, limiting the amount of clean or unpolluted water that may enter into the sanitary sewer system will help to prevent unnecessary sewer backups onto the streets and into the streams and improve the effectiveness of the Township's sewage treatment plants.

### **CLEAN WATER IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY HOW YOU CAN HELP**

If you see any discharge to or from any stormwater basin that looks out of the ordinary – please contact Fairview Township immediately at 717-901-5261.

Do not put oil, gasoline, paint, weed killer, fertilizer, driveway sealer or any other chemical into any storm sewer basin. Do not blow grass clippings into the street or any storm basin as this may clog or contaminate the storm sewer system.

**The cost of cleaning up pollution is more expensive than preventing it in the first place.**

## Top 10 Things Not To Flush or Pour Down Your Drains

1. **Medications** of any kind or hypodermic needles
2. **Cloth** cleaning rags, nylons, mop heads, dental floss
3. **Feminine Products** pads, tampons, applicators
4. **Plastic** bags, swabs, small bottles
5. **Chemicals** cleaning products, insecticides, solvents
6. **Grease & Oil** auto, industrial
7. **Wipes** cleaning, baby, personal hygiene
8. **Cooking Oil/Grease** any fats or oils-used or unused
9. **Condoms** and condom wrappers
10. **Diapers** paper or cloth – **No matter how dirty**

These and similar items can cause major problems in the Wastewater Treatment Plants and Pumping Stations. They can also clog and block your own plumbing and sewer lines which could be very costly for you.

The York County Solid Waste Authority will be holding a **FREE** Household Hazardous Waste drop-off on Saturday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> from 9:00am-1:00pm in the parking lot of Woodland View York, LP which is located at 915 Woodland View Drive, 17406 in Manchester Township. There will be a limited amount of **LOWES GIFT CARDS** given to residents who bring in elemental mercury and/or a mercury-containing device such as thermostats and thermometers. *YCSWA also offers "At Your Door Special Collection" service. Please at 800-449-7587 for information.* Household hazardous waste includes any products from the home that are corrosive (drain cleaners or bleach), flammables (gasoline), reactive (chemistry kits) or toxic (pesticides). The YCSWA asked that you please do not bring alkaline batteries (ie: AAA's, AA's, C's D's. etc), paint or other paint-related products including: latex and oil-based paint, turpentine, paint thinners, varnish and paint strippers or removers. These items can be placed in your house hold trash for collection.
