### Roof Park

On Tuesday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, Fairview Township will hold our second "National Night Out" community celebration at Roof Park, 599 Lewisberry Road, New Cumberland. The concept of National Night Out is to promote strong police-community relationships and improve neighborhood awareness on crime prevention.

There will be informational displays from the Fairview Township Police Department, Fire Department, and Emergency Medical Services, as well as other public safety and community organizations. The Police Department will also be providing Child ID Kits to families that document a child's photograph, fingerprints and DNA in case it is needed in an emergency.

This event is being underwritten by local businesses and organizations through donations of cash, goods and services and will be staffed entirely by volunteers. This is a no-cost event for families; and will include free food, activities for the kids, prize drawings and much more. Festivities will get underway at 5:00 p.m. and run until 9:00 p.m.

## CALL BEFORE YOU DIG

If you are installing a fence, deck or pool, or digging for a tree, mailbox post, patio or other excavation project, it is important for your safety to **Know What's Below**. Your utility companies, such as water, sewer, gas, electric and cable do not want accidents that may cause injuries or disruption of services in your neighborhood.

You, or your contractor, are required by Pennsylvania law to notify all underground utility companies of your intent to dig. This is accomplished with just one phone call to the **PA One Call System at 1-800-242-1776 or simply by dialing 8-1-1** three to ten business days before digging. PA One Call will then notify all utility companies in your area to mark any underground lines they may have with colored flags, paint or chalk. These markings should remain in place until your project is completed.

There is no cost to the homeowner for this service so please be safe and **Call Before You Dig**.

**Pet Owners** are reminded that, by Township ordinance, no animal (dog, cat or any other animal) shall be permitted to run at large, make any noise that disturbs the peace and quiet, or be allowed to defile or defoul sidewalks, walkways or property of others. All animals must be kept under their owners control at all times. Any questions or complaints should be directed to the Police Department at 901-5267.

## Medication Take-back Program

York County residents who have unused or unwanted medications can take them to the Fairview Township Police Department, 145 Limekiln Road, Suite 600, New Cumberland, during normal business hours Monday-Friday 8:00 am - 4:30 pm. and place the medications in a secure lock-box located in the lobby.

Accepted items include: solid or liquid prescription medications, prescription patches, prescription ointments, inhalers, over-the-counter medications, vitamins, and medications for pets.

**Needles, non-prescription liquids, ointments, or lotions are not accepted.**

**YARD WASTE COLLECTION DATES**

***YARD WASTE CONTAINERS ARE TO BE USED FOR YARD WASTE COLLECTION ONLY.***

The waste hauler **WILL NOT** collect your trash or recyclables in them. Please do not dispose of yard waste in bags, boxes, etc. You must follow the preparation guidelines listed on our website to ensure collection.

**GRASS CLIPPINGS** are **NOT** part of yard waste collection. You may use your grass clippings as mulch in your gardens and flower beds OR mow your grass using a mulching mower OR bag and dispose of grass clippings as part of your weekly trash collection.

**Paint Disposal:** Latex and oil-based paint can be disposed of in your regular household trash. Simply add shredded paper, sand or kitty litter in the can to absorb any liquid. Put lid back on can and place paint can into your household trash bag.

**Hazardous Waste Disposal:** Contact the York County Solid Waste Authority at 717.845.1066 (ie: paint thinners, drain cleaners, bleach, flammables (gasoline), reactive (chemistry kits) or toxic (pesticides), etc).

**Rechargeable Battery Disposal:** *(Regular alkaline batteries are to be thrown into your household trash).* Rechargeable batteries such as Nickel Cadmium (NiCd), Nickel Metal Hydride (NiMH) or Lithium Ion (Li-Ion) should be recycled. You may recycle the rechargeable batteries at our electronic recycling center or the following locations:
