Phone Scam Alert

Fairview Township Police Department has been responding to numerous complaints from residents who have been contacted by scammers and con artists. There are numerous scams; however, the most common in this area have been individuals claiming to be working with the IRS, PPL and other companies. Typically the scammer states that the resident or business owner is delinquent in payment of taxes or electric bills.

In most cases, the caller demands payment and threatens the individual with arrest if the funds are not received within a few hours. The scammers are very good and sound professional, so don't be fooled! Residents should be aware of the following guidelines:

1. **The IRS and PPL will not make initial contact by telephone. You will be contacted via US mail.**
2. **If the caller demands payment via Money Gram, Money Order, Green Dot or pre-paid credit cards, it is most likely a scam.**
3. **Contact your financial institution immediately to protect your bank account or credit card information if you provided this information to the scammers.**
4. **Please contact the police if you are not sure if it is a scam, or if you feel you were a victim of a scam.**

Snow Season Approaches!

As much as most of us don't want to think about it, when the leaves start to fall, winter is not far behind. Here are a few reminders:

Plows & Driveways:

Plows travel down the right side of the roadway, the same direction as normal traffic flow. There is no way to avoid plows putting snow at the end of driveways. To minimize the amount of snow placed by a plow, put shoveled snow on the right side of the driveway as you look from your driveway into the street.

2015 Leaf Collection

Leaf collection will begin the week of October 26th. The last collection day will be Friday, December 4th.

- ▶ Leaves will be collected the day after your trash collection day, beginning as early as 6:00 a.m. If your trash day is Friday, leaves will be collected Monday.
- ▶ Our goal is to collect leaves once a week in your neighborhood, however weather, holidays and volume of leaves may affect this schedule.
- ▶ Rake leaves close to the curb or edge of the road without blocking the roadway or storm drains.
- ▶ Do not mix grass or brush with leaves.
- ▶ Leaves in bags or trash cans will not be collected.

Reporting Street Light Outages

Street lights are installed and maintained by the electric company in your area. All outages or damages should be reported directly to them.

If you are a PPL customer, call 1-800-342-5775, press 1, and then press 4.

If you are a MetEd customer, call 1-888-544-4877.

Be prepared to give a street address where the light is located. It is also helpful if you provide the pole number which is posted on each street light.
