Yard Waste and Electronics Recycling

Modified Winter Hours

Beginning Monday, November 3rd, the recycling center, located at 55 Fairview Road, New Cumberland, will observe winter hours as follows:

Monday through Friday – 9:00 a.m. to noon
Every Saturday – 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

This schedule may be adjusted again in the Spring. Check your April newsletter for any changes to the hours of operation.

We thank our residents for their commitment to recycling as we strive to make the center as convenient as possible for your needs.

2014 Leaf Collection

Leaf collection will begin the week of October 27th. The last collection day will be Friday, December 5th.

▶ Leaves will be collected the day after your trash collection day, beginning as early as 6:00 a.m. If your trash day is Friday, leaves will be collected Monday.

▶ Our goal is to collect leaves once a week in your neighborhood, however weather, holidays and volume of leaves may affect this schedule.

▶ Rake leaves close to the curb or edge of the road without blocking the roadway or storm drains.

▶ Do not mix grass or brush with leaves.

▶ Leaves in bags or trash cans will not be collected.

York County Weatherization Program

Administered through the York County Planning Commission, the Weatherization Program is designed to save energy, lower fuel bills and make homes more comfortable in the process. It is open to any York County resident with a limited income.

Specially trained workers can make specified repairs to your home such as attic and basement insulation, hot water heater installation, window and door weather-stripping, caulking, broken glass, etc. In addition they will test your furnace and water heater for efficiency and safety. Inefficient furnaces will be repaired or replaced.

These services are free of charge and no lien will be filed against your home. The program is paid for by the state and federal government through the Department of Energy, Department of Health and Human Services and the County of York.

Snow Season Approaches!

As much as most of us don't want to think about it, when the leaves start to fall, winter is not far behind. Here are a few reminders:

Plows & Driveways:

Plows travel down the right side of the roadway, the same direction as normal traffic flow. There is no way to avoid plows putting snow at the end of driveways. To minimize the amount of snow placed by a plow, put shoveled snow on the right side of the driveway as you look from your driveway into the street.

Emergency Notification System

Residents are reminded that Fairview Township now has an automated Emergency Notification System for the purpose of alerting Township residents and businesses of important issues dealing with health, safety and other critical incidents such as weather emergencies.

With winter approaching and the possibility of major snow and ice events, you are encouraged to register your contact information by going to the Township website, www.twp.fairview.pa.us so that you can be notified of any emergency situation.

Reporting Street Light Outages

Street lights are installed and maintained by the electric company in your area. All outages should be reported directly to them.

If you are a PPL customer, call 1-800-342-5775, press 1, then press 4.

If you are a MetEd customer, call 1-888-544-4877.

Be prepared to give a street address where the light is located. It is also helpful if you provide the pole number which is posted on each street light.

Fire Prevention Week – October 6 – 11, 2014

There will be an open house at the Fairview Township Fire Station #1, 340 Lewisberry Road, New Cumberland, on Wednesday, October 8th from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. Residents are encouraged to stop by to meet your firefighters and tour the facility.

Daylight Savings Time ends Sunday, November 2nd. Turn your clocks back one hour. This is a also a good time to check your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and replace the batteries to be sure they are in good working order.

You should receive a Trash/Sewer bill four (4) times a year, on or about January 1st, April 1st, July 1st and October 1st. If you do not receive a bill by the dates listed, please contact the Trash & Sewer department at (717) 901-5230.
