## **Township Employees Give Back To The Community**

Continuing our yearly tradition, twenty-five Fairview Township families were the recipients of a complete ready-to-cook Christmas dinner basket that contained a turkey and all the trimmings, compliments of Township employees who donated all the food items. The Township worked in partnership with the Red Land Community Action Program (REDCAP) who distributed the baskets.

## **Brown Leaves Office After 15 Years of Service to Fairview**

Colonel William C. (Chuck) Brown has returned to the role of private citizen after serving Fairview Township in several capacities for the past 15 years. He served on the Zoning Hearing Board from 1999 – 2001, and the Sewer Authority from 2002 – 2013. First elected to the Board of Supervisors in 2001, he served two six-year terms on the Board from 2002 through 2013.

At their last meeting on December 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Supervisors recognized Mr. Brown's service by announcing that a park bench will be placed in Roof Park, dedicated to his commitment and service to Fairview Township and its residents.

Newly elected Supervisor, John W. Jones, will be sworn in to begin his first six-year term on the Board at the Reorganization Meeting on January 6, 2014. A long time Township resident, Mr. Jones has served on the Township's Recreation Commission since 2001.

Robert P. Stanley, Jr., appointed in 2012 to fill a vacant two-year term, was re-elected for a two-year term, and will also be sworn in on January 6<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Jones and Mr. Stanley join Board members Mario D. Pirritano, Supervisor since 2000, John C. Minito, Supervisor since 2006, and Christopher L. Allen, Supervisor since 2012.

## **Recycling Grant**

Fairview Township was awarded a recycling grant through the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) in the amount of \$86,946. With this grant money, the Township was reimbursed for a leaf loader that was purchased in 2008, and purchased a new leaf loader to replace a 1995 leaf loader. Some additional miscellaneous leaf collection equipment, such as leaf boxes for the dump trucks and leaf blowers were also purchased. The grant also provided the funds to update the refuse/recycling link on the Township's website.

## **New Web Site in Development**

As a result of many requests and suggestions for improving communication with our residents, the Township is in the process of developing a new format for our website. The updated look and ease of navigation should make our site more user-friendly. It will contain all the information currently available, but will add more current information as well as archives of historical documents.



# 2014 FAIRVIEW TOWNSHIP BUDGET


## WHERE DOES YOUR PROPERTY TAX DOLLAR GO?

For every dollar paid for property taxes, 65 cents goes to the School District, 23 cents to the county, 10 cents to the Township, 1 cent each to the Fire and EMS departments.




The Township Supervisors adopted the 2014 budget without a tax increase. The approved budget for the general fund calls for the spending of \$6,397,845. An estimated \$6,736,500 is expected from revenue sources. The graphs below show the allocation of revenues and expenditures. In addition, Capital purchases to replace two police cars, two fire trucks, two township trucks and a street sweeper have been approved. ## **CHRISTMAS TREE DISPOSAL**

***Christmas trees will be collected curbside January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013.***

Please make sure Christmas trees are free of any lights and decorations (ie: tinsel, ornaments, etc.) to ensure collection. If these items are left on your Christmas tree, it will not be collected. You are also welcome to take your Christmas tree to the Yard Waste Facility during the hours of operation (hours are listed below).

## **YARD WASTE AND ELECTRONIC RECYCLING DROP-OFF:**

**Address:** 55 Fairview Road, New Cumberland, PA 17070  
**Hours:** Monday – Friday: 9am - 12noon (except holidays)  
Every Saturday: 8:00am – 4:30pm (except holidays)

**WOOD/COAL ASH DISPOSAL:** Ash must be cool to the touch. Place ash in plastic garbage bag and set out with your regular trash.

**PAINT:** Latex and oil-based paint can be disposed of in your regular household trash. Simply add shredded paper, sand or kitty litter in the can to absorb any liquid. Put lid back on can and place paint can into your household trash bag.

**GASOLINE & KEROSENE DISPOSAL:** Check with your local auto garages as well as Pep Boys, AutoZone, Advanced Auto Parts, Target, Wal-Mart, Etc.

**RECHARGEABLE BATTERY DISPOSAL LOCATIONS:** (Regular alkaline batteries are to be thrown into your household trash). Rechargeable batteries such as Nickel Cadmium (NiCd), Nickel Metal Hydride (NiMH) or Lithium Ion (Li-Ion) should be recycled.
