

## **YARD WASTE AND ELECTRONICS RECYCLING CENTER**

### **EXPANDED SUMMER HOURS**

For your convenience, Fairview Township's Recycling Center for Yard Waste and Electronics is now open all day, six days a week through the summer. Weekdays, except holidays, the hours are 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The center will also be open every Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Since the beginning of 2013, residents have filled four tractor trailers with old computers and other electronics and we are now well on the way to filling number five. In addition, more than 1,700 residents have dropped off yard waste and 1,200 have picked up the free shredded mulch.

Thanks to your recycling efforts, the Township received a state grant this year in the amount of \$39,232 based on curbside recycling and an additional amount of \$7,620 was received from the York County Solid Waste Authority for the sale of scrap electronics. In addition, the Township has entered into an agreement with the Department of Environmental Protection for a municipal recycling grant in the amount of \$86,946.00. These funds will be used for the replacement of our aging leaf collection equipment.

## **ROAD MAINTENANCE 2013**

Bids were recently opened and awarded for the paving of portions of Big Spring Road and Fairview Road. This project will be completed by the end of August. Additional streets may be addressed if funding becomes available. Township crews will be patching roads in various locations and traffic lines will be painted after completion of paving and patching. You are reminded to stay a safe distance behind the line painting equipment and not to drive over the fresh paint to avoid getting paint on your vehicle.

## **ACT 537 PUBLIC SEWER PROJECT**

Bids were received in June for the construction of sewer mains and pump stations for Phase I, which includes the Timber Ridge area. More information on the details of timing of the construction and the impact on roads in the area in the short and long term will be provided to the affected property owners.

Within the next 60 days, another public meeting will be scheduled for input and comment from those residents in Phase II. These property owners will be notified by mail of the time and place of the meeting. You are encouraged to attend the meeting to address any questions or concerns you may have about the project.

## **VOLUNTEER DRIVERS NEEDED**

Volunteer drivers are needed to deliver Meals on Wheels to senior citizens in the Fairview Township area. Meals for our residents are delivered from the Northeastern Senior Center in Mt. Wolf.

## **UV SYSTEM INSTALLED NORTHERN WASTEWATER FACILITY**

Under a mandate from the PA Department of Environmental Protection, Fairview Township recently completed the installation of a \$1.2 million Ultra-Violet disinfection system at the Northern Area Wastewater Treatment Facility.

This Ultra-Violet system eliminates the use of chlorine in the processing of wastewater from the public sanitary sewer system.

## HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

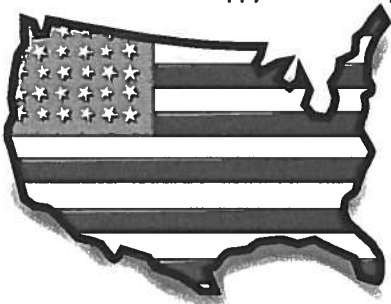
All Township offices will be closed on the following dates:

### **PORTION OF OLD YORK ROAD TO REMAIN CLOSED THIS SUMMER**

The PA Turnpike Commission is replacing the bridge that crosses over the PA Turnpike on Old York Road. The existing bridge will be removed and replaced throughout the summer and the new bridge is expected to re-open by the end of October, 2013.

During construction there will be no through traffic going South from Normandy Drive and no traffic going North from Marsh Run Road. As a result all traffic will be detoured to Interstate 83.

Fairview Township is in the process of implementing an Emergency Telephone Notification System for the purpose of alerting Township residents and businesses of important issues dealing with health, safety and other critical incidents.

You must follow the preparation guidelines listed on our website to ensure collection.

**GRASS CLIPPINGS** are NOT part of yard waste collection. You may use your grass clippings as mulch in your gardens and flower beds OR mow your grass using a mulching mower OR bag and dispose of grass clippings as part of your weekly trash collection.
