RE: Phase I-Act 537 update on connecting requirements

Dear Resident:

The Township appreciates those of you who have worked with us in trying to have your sewer connections completed by the 6th of August 2015.

Some of you have contacted the Township and due to scheduling issues with your contractors indicated that you will not be able to meet that date. Some contractors have also contacted the Township with inquires as to whether we would give extensions for connection due to their scheduling issues.

To minimize your cost, **the Township will provide another extension until September 4th** for connections to the sewer system.

We have also been in contact with PA American, as you know, the Township will be providing the meter pits and having them installed for you at no cost.

The meter pits are on order, but at this time have not been delivered.

Based upon preliminary discussion, the meter pits will be installed first on Lewisberry Road and then the construction will move to the Timber Ridge Development. Our understanding, at this time is that the installation of the individual water lines in Timber Ridge will be by open cut in the roads. The presence of a significant number of underground utilities precludes boring. As soon as that is determined, we will follow up with you.

Please proceed with your applications for permits at this time. As there is no cost for the permit, this will allow us to determine those who have connected and those who have made applications for the entire project.

We appreciate your cooperation on this project and hope to bring it to a conclusion in a relatively short period of time.

Some have asked about the status of the pending sale of the sewer system to PA American, and at this time we can really only say that the appropriate paper work has been filed with the Public Utility Commission and it is currently under review.
