VI. 2017 Budget Review:

1. Fire Department Presentation – Eric Hawkins/Jeff Severance

Deputy Chief Hawkins gave an overview of the success of the Fire Department and requested the Board consider replacing the rescue truck at a net cost of \$600,000.00. With this purchase the Fire Department should not need to replace large equipment for 7 years.

The Board directed Mr. Martin to include the purchase of the rescue in the budget, to be paid for out of the capital reserve fund.

2. The 2017 Budget was discussed

The Board directed Mr. Martin to pursue the possible implementation of an alternate healthcare plan.

The Board directed Mr. Martin to fund the purchase of the Highway Equipment from the capital reserve fund rather than the liquid fuels fund.
