**VI. 2026 BUDGET REVIEW:**

**A. Police Department**

Chief Holland gave a presentation on the current staffing of the police department and the growth in the Township to support a request to add one officer at the start of 2026 and a second officer in the third quarter of 2026.

Mr. Martin stated that the current budget being discussed tonight included the addition of one police officer and the addition of a second officer could be reviewed later in 2026 with updated revenues and the status of growth and development in the Township.

**A. 2026 Budget Presentation**

Mr. Martin gave a presentation of the 5-year road paving program and Budget for 2026 for all funds. The following items were discussed and of note to be included in the current budget.

- No tax increase
- Health Insurance premiums will increase 20% for 2026.
- One additional police officer and one additional Highway crew member
- 3% pay increase for nonunion employees
- 3% pay increase for 9 police officers and 6.7%-8.5% increase for 10 officers that reached steps in accordance with the collective bargaining agreement.

Annual contributions to Community organizations and vehicle and equipment purchases for 2026 as well as grants applied for to offset the cost of vehicle and equipment purchases.

The EMS organization has requested an additional \$2,000 per month of support from the Township.
