I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. Stanley, at 5:00 p.m.

V. RECOGNITION OF PUBLIC

Vicki Wickwire of Old Quaker Road commented that the Supervisors could not be heard in the recording of the October 15, 2015 budget meeting. Mr. Stanley advised that the audio has been corrected for tonight and future meetings.

VI. BUSINESS ITEMS

Peter Ruth, Stock and Leader, advised that the Board should act on the resignation of the tax collector. Mr. Allen made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jones to accept the resignation of the tax collector, Patricia Gordon. Vote on the motion: All yes. The motion carried.

VII. 2016 BUDGET REVIEW

Mr. Smith advised that the budget was prepared with the assumption that the sewer system will be sold by the end of the year. Mr. Smith discussed the following highlights of the draft budget.

- reduction in staff
- 50% reduction in real estate taxes.
- LST revenue to cover general fund expense now that the fire station debt has been repaid.
- Significant increases are expected in the future in Liquid Fuels money to fund future highway projects.

Mr. Smith gave an update on the sale of the sewer system. The agreements between Fairview Township and Lower Allen Township have been accepted. The lease between the Township and PA American Water for the recycling center has been accepted. The permit from York County Conservation for Phase II has been obtained.

Mr. Pirritano commented that acceptance of the resignation of the tax collector was not on the Agenda. He asked if the Board could rescind it. Peter Ruth advised that the Board accepted the resignation.
