BACKGROUND

This decision of the Fairview Township Zoning Hearing Board (the “**Board**”) is from from an application filed by CJSPT, LLC (the “**Applicant**”) with Fairview Township (the “**Township**”) on or about June 21, 2022 (the “**Application**”), seeking zoning relief under the Township’s Zoning Ordinance (the “**Ordinance**”) for a dimensional variance from § 300-71(N)(1) of the Ordinance to reduce the width of access drives for a proposed mini-storage warehouse from 30’ required by the Ordinance to a width of 26’. The subject property is located at Lewisberry Road, Lewisberry, PA 17339, UPI No. 27-000-SF-0005.C0-00000 (the “**Property**”), which is located in the Commercial Business (CB) District.

A hearing was held on the Application on Thursday, July 21, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. at the Fairview Township Building. The Zoning Hearing Board was represented by Timothy Mader (Chairman) and Mark Perry. Alternate Daniel Alderman was in attendance but recused himself and did not participate in the hearing. The Applicant was advised of the recusal and that only two members of the Board would be voting on the Application. The Applicant chose to proceed with the Application. All published and posted notices were duly given, with no objection thereto being made in writing or orally at the time of the hearing. No testimony in opposition to the Application was offered or taken, and no parties attended the hearing in opposition. After hearing the testimony and viewing the evidence in this matter, the Board makes the following determinations:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. CJSPT, LP (“**Applicant**”) is the current owner of property located along Lewisberry Road, Lewisberry, Pennsylvania 17339, UPI # 27-000-SF-0005.C0-00000, consisting of approximately 14.5479 acres (the “**Property**”).

2. The Application proposes a min-storage warehouse facility (the “**Proposed Facility**”) which is a permitted use in the CB District.

3. Chris Hoover, P.E., Hoover engineering, Inc., also testified on behalf of Applicant. Mr. Hoover introduced a site plan that was attached to the Application and will be referred to as Exhibit 2.

4. The Proposed Facility will consist of an L-shaped building that will be climate-controlled self-storage and a portion that will be small shops with electricity.

5. The Property will also have five parallel buildings with self-storage units. The first building will be indoor RV storage and the remaining buildings will be typical mini-storage warehouse units.

6. Layout for the Proposed Facility was purchased from Trac Rite which is a nationally-recognized self-storage solutions vendor.

7. The industry standard aisle width is 25-30’ based on research Mr. Hoover performed on the internet.

8. The Trac Rite design proposes a 26’ aisle width.

9. Mr. Hoover testified that the topography and location of the site restricts the area of the site that may be developed. The site is located within the centerline approach grade of the Capitol City Airport in New Cumberland. There are numerous aviation easements that directly impact and limit the ability to develop the Property. The aviation easements strictly limit the height of any structures on the Property.

10. Mr. Hoover testified the configuration could not be changed due to the aviation easements, but failed to provide any evidence, drawings, simulations or reports that analyzed the impact of the aviation easements on the height of buildings at the proposed locations or any alternative locations on the site.

11. Mr. Hoover testified that a 30’ aisle between rows could be achieved by eliminating one of the parallel storage buildings. There are also other possible customized configurations of the Property that would allow for 30’ aisles between rows or at least an aisle width closer to 30’.

12. Stephen Waller, Township Zoning Officer, testified on behalf of the Township. Mr. Waller confirmed the notice requirements for the Application have been met. He also testified that he agrees with Mr. Hoover that the aviation easements restrict the Property development, but did not give specific details of the height restrictions for the specific buildings of the Proposed Facility.

13. Mr. Waller noted for the Board and the Applicant that the Ordinance may be updated to amend aisle widths to meet industry standards. Mr. Waller testified that he does not recall any specific reason or rationale why the aisle width should be 30’ in the ordinance. Industry standards may have also changed over time.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Applicant has failed to establish the elements required for a dimensional variance from § 300-71(N)(1) of the Ordinance to reduce the width of access drives for a proposed mini-storage warehouse from 30' required by the Ordinance to a width of 26'.
2. The Applicant has not established that the Proposed Facility may not be developed in strict conformance with the Ordinance. The testimony confirms the Proposed Facility may be developed in strict conformance with the Ordinance but the Applicant prefers to not do so for financial reasons and convenience, which are not grounds for a variance.
3. The hardship is self-created because the Applicant has chosen a plan set that does not comply with the Ordinance when other plan sets or custom plans may be available that do comply with the Ordinance.
4. The requested dimensional variance exceeds the minimum variance that will afford relief because alternative layouts would reduce the variance from the aisle width or eliminate the need for a variance entirely.

DECISION

Mr. Perry moved to deny the dimensional variance from § 300-71(N)(1) of the Ordinance to reduce the width of access drives for a proposed mini-storage warehouse from 30' required by the Ordinance to a width of 26' because the Application fails to meet the requirements of § 300-99(E)(4)(b), (c) and (e) based on the testimony presented. Mr. Mader seconded the motion. Upon a vote, the Fairview Township Zoning Hearing Board unanimously denied the motion. Mr. Alderman abstained from the vote.

Mr. Perry further moved to recommend the Fairview Township Board of Supervisors consider a text amendment to the Ordinance to reduce the required aisle width for a mini-storage warehouse. Mr. Mader seconded the motion. Upon a vote, the Fairview Township Zoning Hearing Board unanimously approved the motion. Mr. Alderman abstained from the vote.

APPLICANT SHALL ABIDE BY ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS, REGULATIONS AND ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO PERMISSIONS GRANTED BY THIS DECISION.

APPLICANT SHALL PROCEED PURSUANT TO THIS DECISION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS PRESENTED AT THE HEARING.

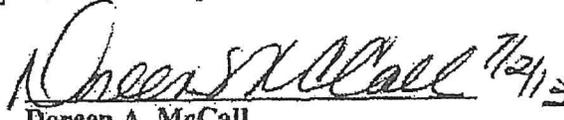


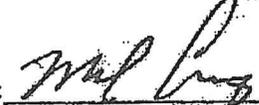
It is recommended that the Commission authorize and approve the following:

In order to construct the total reconstruction project between mileposts 242 and 245, it is necessary to take property owned by CJSPT, LP (WBS Element No. T-242.00T002-4-08; R/W 3375-A); a partial take. Negotiations with the property owners have been successful. Accordingly, the Legal Department requests that the Commission approve the acquisition of R/W 3375-A by authorizing the issuance of a check in the amount of \$40,836.22, payable to CJSPT, LP (representing \$40,500.00, fair market value; and, \$336.22, pro-rated taxes). Further to authorize the appropriate Commission officials to execute the agreement of sale, and other documents that may be required for closing, and to authorize the payment of additional statutory damages, as calculated by the Right-of-Way Administrator and approved by the Chief Counsel. ITE PLAN ESSENTIALS

Building Setbacks are the legal distance your buildings may be placed away from the property line according to your local zoning restrictions. Parking and drive aisles are usually permitted in the setback area, but no permanent structures. Front setbacks may have provisions for widening the road or landscaping requirements.

Utility Easements are also areas where permanent structures are prohibited. Check your Deed Restrictions and local Planning & Zoning Regulations carefully for other types of easements and restrictions.

Access to the Rental Office and ample customer parking should be located OUTSIDE the security gate. Handicap parking should be clearly labeled and closest to the door. The Approach and Entrance to the facility should be wide enough to allow passing vehicles and long enough to get visitors safely off the roadway. Vehicle Stacking before the Security Gate should be at least Three Deep. We recommend that drive widths at the entrance be at least 30 feet.

Drive Aisles should be wide enough to provide ample turning radius for commercial vehicles and the passing of unloading vehicles. For driveways between buildings with outside storage we recommend a minimum of 25 feet for the longest parallel drives and 30 feet for the cross aisles. RV's and Fire Engines require drive aisles wide enough for proper turn radius. Keep in mind that your local Fire Marshal may have to sign off on your Site Plan.

Drive Aisles for RV/Boat Storage should be at least 35 feet wide for 60-degree angled parking and 55 feet for 90-degree parking.

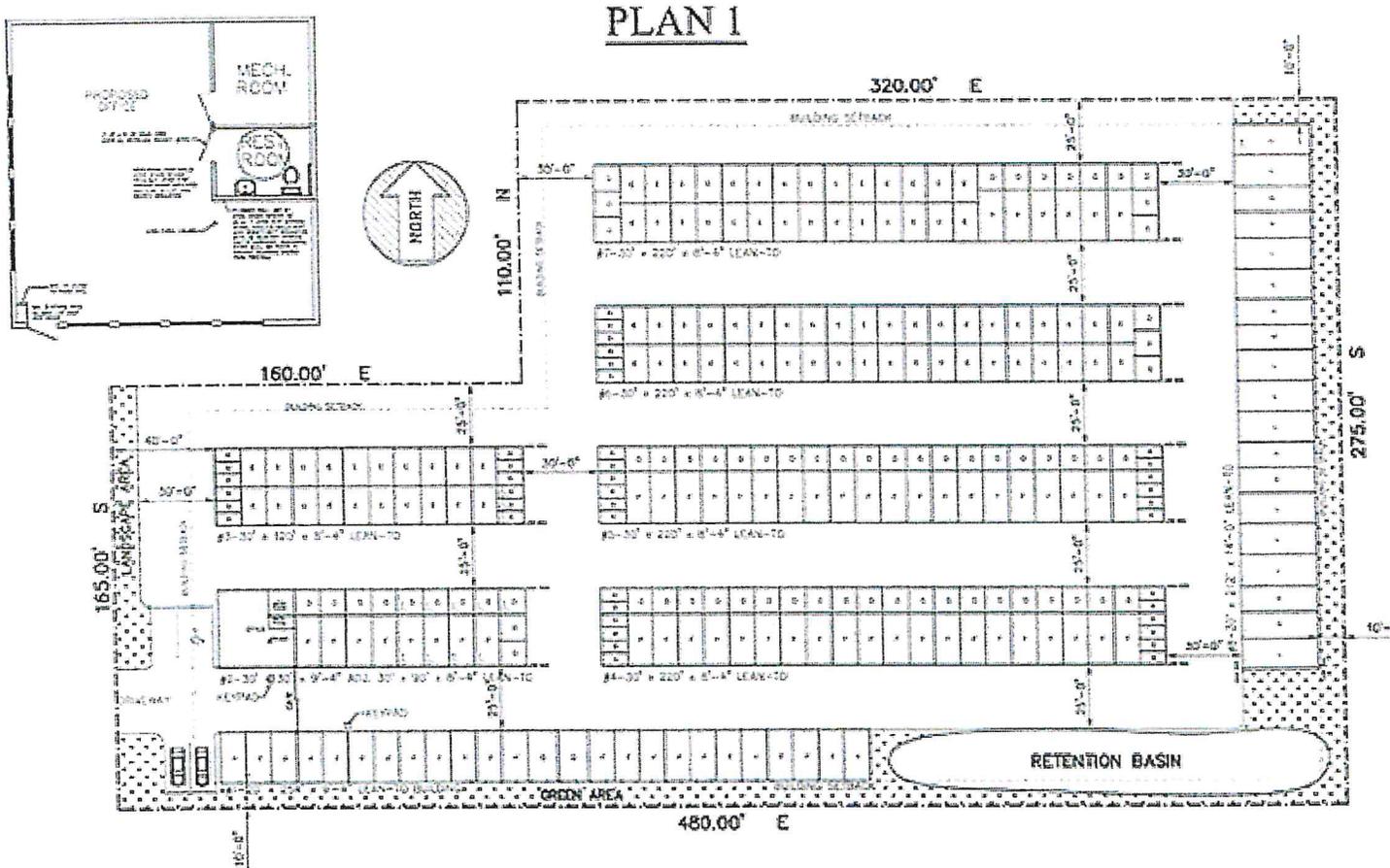
Your site may require a Retention Basin for on-site detention of storm water runoff. We recommend placing it in the lowest rear corner of the property. The entire site should be graded to drain towards the Retention Basin.

Gaps between long buildings will provide access to maintain the setback area and a place to push snow in winter climates.

Cement-filled bollards will protect the corners of your buildings from damage by "Yahoos in U-Hauls".

Plan 1 - Traditional drive-up units

This plan demonstrates a typical Trachte customer site. In most cases, the developer would phase the project to reduce the upfront cost. Building only the structures needed at first reduces interest expense during the first years of business, and allows you to fine tune the unit mix in later phases. Some developers choose to build the perimeter buildings first if they serve as a fence. Some developers also choose to pour the foundations for future buildings up front to avoid bringing in heavy equipment later.
