** Amazon has had a temporary decrease due to a reorganization but will see a large increase in the near future as they ramp up their operations again at our warehouse.


Traffic

Pending Development

- 130 new residential units in last 10 months
- 115 new building permits issued in last 1 ½ month
 - Includes a 72-unit apartment building
- Over 2,700 new residential units when currently planned developments are completed.
