ADOPTING THE FAIRVIEW TOWNSHIP EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN UPDATE 2026

This plan was prepared in cooperation with the Fairview Township Emergency Management Agency, York County Office of Emergency Management and the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency.

THIS RESOLUTION, approved and adopted by the Supervisors of Fairview Township, York County, Pennsylvania, on the date hereinafter set forth.

WHEREAS, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa. C.S.), as amended, mandates that Fairview Township prepare, maintain and keep current an emergency operations plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster within this Township; and

WHEREAS, in response to the mandate stated above, this Township has prepared an emergency operations plan to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster; and

WHEREAS, this Township has also prepared an emergency operations plan in order to reduce the potential effects of a major emergency or disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors of Fairview Township do hereby approve, adopt and place into immediate effect the Radiological Emergency Response Procedures of Fairview Township. This Plan shall be reviewed on an annual basis to make certain that it conforms with the requirements of the York County Radiological Emergency Response Procedures.
