DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about July 4th and July 5th, 2026 severe thunderstorms occurred causing injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of Fairview Township, York County and

WHEREAS, the disaster endangered the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of people residing in Fairview Township, York County, and created problems greater in scope than Fairview Township, York County may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in Fairview Township, York County;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Donald F. Martin, III, the undersigned Manager of Fairview Township, York County, pursuant to Chapter 282, Part 53 of the Code of Ordinances of Fairview Township and as authorized under the provisions of § 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., § 7501), as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a Disaster Emergency in Fairview Township, York County;

FURTHER, I direct the Fairview Township Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.

STILL FURTHER, I authorize officials of Fairview Township, York County to act as necessary to meet the current demands of this emergency, namely: by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

This Declaration shall be in effect July 4th, 2026 and shall terminate July 30, 2026.
